## FORWARD



Greetings in the Lord!

Social upheavals in South Korea in tandem with Japanese colonization (1910~1945) and the Korean War (1950~1953) brought agony and impoverishment to the "Hermit" nation in the Far East. The seed of the "Hope of God" fell to the poor, humble, fertile soil of young souls and budded within the college campuses of South Korea through multiple evangelical movements. Since the early 1960s, the LORD

God has poured unto us, His unending love and vision for salvation for all mankind, especially from college campuses in South Korea. God listened to our prayers for world missions and opened the door for sending out lay missionaries, predominantly as nurses in the first wave in the late 1960s and early 1970s, to West Germany and other countries including the United States. Gradually the Holy Spirit has opened the door more widely for world mission efforts from South Korea as well as through us.

The new millennium has brought forth a need for thorough self-examination and contemplation upon our activities and how we have operated our mission organization. With the help of God, we started afresh worldwide as Campus Mission International and within the United States and Canada as Campus Mission International North America (CMINA) in 2003. Since its inception in 2003, CMINA has established local churches, hosted national meetings, and reignited God's calling for us to reside in the Lord, call young souls to the Lord and feed the lambs of Jesus. In January 2020 at the CMI Oceania International Conference, a Global CMI was launched for us to support world missions more effectively. CMINA is looking up to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, in prayer so that the Lord may use us as a mustard seed to grow and serve a multitude of hungry souls in North America and the world.

### **Purpose**

CMINA association exists so that through the preaching of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the Gospel of God's grace may create a faith of salvation in Jesus Christ. CMINA association is "the assembly of all believers among whom the Gospel is preached in its purity and accepted with the confession of faith."

#### Mission

The mission of the CMINA Association is twofold: to minister to (1) non-believers, focusing on young people through the preaching of the Gospel of Jesus Christ as the Holy Spirit leads; and (2) to members, as the Holy Spirit strengthens and supports believers in each local church, other countries and to participate in world evangelism.

### Ministry

The ministry of CMINA Association encompasses, but is not limited to, the following:

### 1. Ministry of the Word and Sacrament

We support ministers, missionaries and other servants of Christ to preach and teach God's holy, inspired Word in all its truth and to carry out this task through prayer in the Holy Spirit in accordance with our Lord's command (Matthew 28:18-20). We respond to the Word with prayer, praise and thanksgiving (Colossians 3:16-17).

#### 2. Nurture

We conduct an educational ministry for the members of the fellowship through various types of Bible-study training to strengthen the members in their faith and in their knowledge of God's will. (Ephesians 4:11-16).

### 3. Fellowship

We provide for fellowship between people of like faith and commitment (Acts 2:42), since we are a people bound together as brothers and sisters of Christ (the family of God).


#### 4. World Mission

We support outreach ministries and the raising up of disciples of Christ into Bible teachers and missionaries in the local chapters.

## MINISTRY DEPARTMENTS

CMINA is aimed at evangelizing college students and building churches by working according to the gifts God has given to each of us. The ministries in CMINA will be enhanced

by volunteers for activities in a department of their interest or talents. For further inquiries about each department, please contact the presidential team.

DEPARTMENT	ACTIVITIES
PRESIDENTIAL TEAM	The presidential team conducts the General Assembly meetings and performs other duties as specified in the Bylaws. The president presides over all meetings of the General Assembly and other special meetings. They sign all legal documents on the behalf of the church.
THE BOARD of DIRECTORS	The Board of Directors, consisting of seven members, shall determine all of the important affairs of the church and present them to the general assembly for approval or a vote
COMMITTEES	Committees shall be organized for the purpose of addressing specific issues, such as education, finance, web-site management, daily devotion booklets, public relations, officer nominations, mediation, and any other issues that may arise.
ADVISORY COUNCIL	The advisory council consists of the first president and other members who are nominated by the nomination committee and approved by the general assembly. The advisory council functions as a think tank, prepares Bible-study materials, and acts as a consultant to the presidents and other officers.
THE INTEGRATION OF CMINA	The integration of the CMINA exists for the sake of local churches' cooperation, administration and disciple as well as the conservation of Christian teachings, because there are local churches in the CMINA.
FINANCIAL TEAM	The financial team records and deposits the regular and special offerings of the church, and has authority over the disbursement of church funds in the church.
WORLD MISSION TEAM	The world mission team will have a network with global missionaries and help them and report about world mission fields.
EDUCATION TEAM	Education team develops the bible study materials and daily bread.
YOUNG GENERATION TEAM	Members of the young generation form a close-knit communication network with each other to encourage each other, and build up a community of faith in CMI North America and in their campuses.
MEDIA TEAM	The media team develops and manages the websites of CMI and each church. They publish webzine.



#### Myanmar

A co-operative mission work between Myanmar and CMINA started in 2007. Missionary Peter Chung in Pittsburgh, PA met Pastor David Lian while studying together at the Pittsburgh Theological Seminary in 2005. With the support of many coworkers around the world, the Myanmar Undergraduate School of Theology (MUST) was established in 2007, followed by the Agape House (an orphanage ministry) in 2009. The CMI Myanmar ministry began in 2011.

For the past years, 85 CMI members from 11 different countries have visited MUST and the Agape House and served in short term mission in Myanmar. The young 2nd generation members from the U.S., Korea, Canada, Germany, Australia and C nation have hosted Vacation Bible School every summer in Myanmar for the past six years. A medical mission team from Columbus Ohio came and served in 2015.

### **Dominican Republic**

The medical mission team from Columbus CMI had a short term medical mission trip during the Spring of 2016 (March 7th to 13th) to three CMI ministries in the Dominican Republic: the Ezra school and churches run by Nehemiah and Lydia Park, a Haitian refugee ministry operated by Rebekah Kim, and the ministry in Santo Domingo by Moses Kim.




